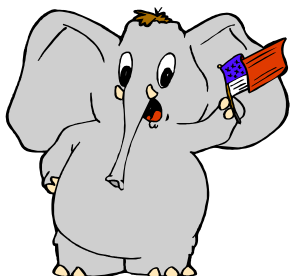

****SCRWC BY-LAWS MODIFICATIONS****

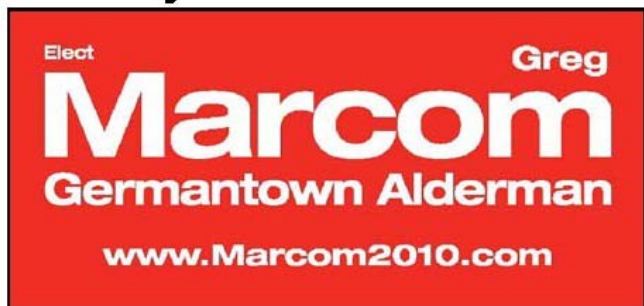
Enclosed with this newsletter are proposed modifications to the SCRWC by-laws, which will be up for member vote of approval at the October 12 General Meeting.
