

Election Information...

It is time to inform neighbors who have moved into your area in the last year or so about:

1. TN requirement for proper registration is at least 30 days before Election Day with current address.

- Voters do not register by political party in TN.
 A photo ID issued by the Federal Government or TN State Government is required to vote.

YOUR VOTING CALENDAR

Early Voting: April 13 - April 28 for May 3 Primary Election. You can vote at any location. The first two days of Early Voting are April 13 and 14 - 9:00a-5:00p - at 157 Poplar Saturday, April 16: Hours 10:00a-4:00p are extended at the following sites: AgriCenter; Arlington Safe House; Baker Comm. Center; Dave Wells; Glenview; 157 Poplar. Monday, April 18: ALL 26 Early Voting Sites Open. Hours: 11:00a-7:00p Saturday, April 23: Hours: 8:00a-4:00p April 25, April 28: Hours: 11:00a-7:00p

PRIMARY ELECTION DAY IS MAY 3 - You can only vote at your assigned precinct on Election Day. If your site has changed, you have been notified by mail. Verify at shelbyvote.com.

You will be asked for ballot choice (R or D). Primary Elections enable political parties to select their candidate for General Elections. Your choice does not limit your selection for the August Election.

Positions include: District Attorney General, County Mayor, County Commissioners; Assessor, Juvenile Court Clerk, Trustee; Circuit Court Clerk, and many additional clerk positions. Vote your choice; local politicians influence your daily life!
