Legislative News

H.R. 2, the Secure the Border Act of 2023 - House Republicans Take Action to Secure the Border and Restore the Rule of Law

The Biden administration's open-border policies have led to an unprecedented national security and humanitarian crisis at our southern border. For more than two years, President Biden and Democrats in Congress have ignored this crisis. House Republicans made tackling this border crisis a central component to the GOPs Commitment to America. The Secure the Border Act is structured with two fundamental goals: secure the border and combat illegal immigration.

The legislation will: force the Biden Administration to restart construction of the border wall; deploy technology to the southern and northern border; increase the number of Border Patrol agents and provide bonus pay; require transparency regarding illegal crossings from the Department of Homeland Security; strengthen current law to protect unaccompanied children from human trafficking; end catch and release; end abuse of executive immigration authority; and strengthen and streamline the asylum process.

This bill passed in the House on May 11, 2023 and goes to the Senate next for consideration.

Too many elections? You need to know the five specific districts in which you vote (six are in Memphis). The other elections (President, Senate, Governor, Judges, etc.) are open to all. Municipal officers are elected by residents within that city. Some changes have been made. Put a note on your To-Do List to download the app for access to your district numbers at GoVoteTN.gov.

Special elections can happen unexpectedly with resignations or death. Be prepared by knowing your districts. Also, those of you who may have committed an action causing loss of your voting rights should call 222-1200 and ask for Vickie to learn if you may now be eligible to vote.

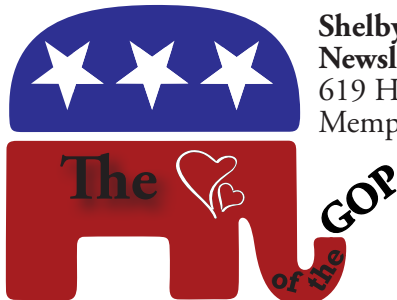
