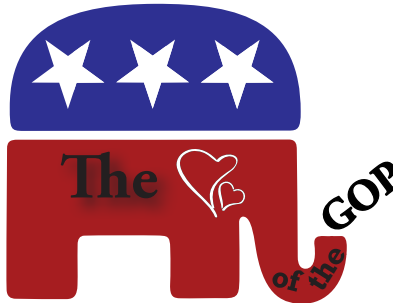

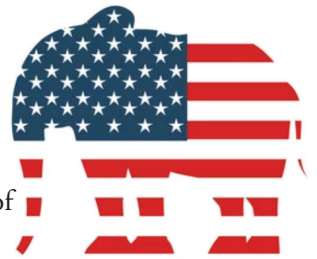

Election Information...

A new law has been passed to further enhance the excellent TN election laws. Beginning this cycle, absentee ballots will not only have a numbering system registered to an individual, but the ballots themselves will be printed on unique watermarked paper. These enhancements will immediately identify an absentee ballot and perhaps make sorting a little faster. Numbers on returned absentee ballots will continue to be verified with mailed ballots. This feature adds a small cost to the price of an absentee ballot and will slightly increase the overall cost of conducting elections, but it should be further reassuring to those who question security.

Beginning with this election cycle, you will have a new precinct number. This change will not require any action by you. You will be notified by mail if your voting location changes, so carefully review your mail. Rather than alphabetic precinct names as in the past, they will now be numeric. Beginning in the north corners of the county, the first two numbers will indicate your County Commission district.

The 10-year redistricting may change coverage lines for state representatives. Some areas in Germantown formerly in State Rep Dist. 96 are now in State Dist. 83. After a 10-year census, districts are adjusted as necessary to give elected officials approximately the same number of voters to serve. Shelby County's population continues to move eastward.

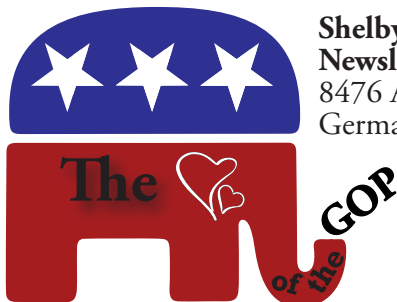
