

November Election Information...

The Nov 8 General Election is the last of Tennessee's long 2022 election season, but it is certainly not the least! You will elect the Governor, State Senator and State Reps, and U.S. Rep, plus mayors, aldermen, school board members in five municipalities (Arlington elections were earlier). One special Memphis Judicial position will be on Memphis ballots.

Early voting begins Wed Oct 19th and ends Thurs Nov 3rd. Vote early!

There are 26 convenient Early Voting locations in the county and 13 days to vote. 65% of Shelby County citizens did not vote in August. That helps incompetent candidates win. Precinct changes were mailed to all registered voters. If you misplaced that information, check goVoteTN.com for your location.

Oct 11 is the last day to register. Proof of citizenship and residency is required. Go to shelbyvote.com for easily available information. If you need an absentee ballot, call 222-1200; the ballot must be returned by mail to the Shelby County Election Commission before 4:30pm on Election Day.



Legislative News ... Judy Kilmer

Tennesseans will vote on these 4 amendments to the state constitution this November: Amendment 1: Right-to-Work= makes it illegal for workplaces to mandate union membership or dues as a condition of employment. Please VOTE YES on #1 to preserve our Tennessee tradition.

Amendment 2: Assigning an Acting Governor= amendment would add new wording to include situations where the governor is temporarily unable to perform their duties, such as for medical reasons, then the speaker of the Senate is first in line to assume the governor's responsibilities as acting governor.

Amendment 3: Removing Slavery as a Punishment for Crime would update language in the state's constitution that, as currently written, is worded to technically allow slavery and indentured servitude as a punishment for crime. Tennessee's constitution outlaws' slavery.

Amendment 4: Removing the Religious Minister Disqualification=would delete a section in the constitution that was written to prevent "ministers of the Gospel" and priests of any denomination from holding office in the state.

These Amendments must get more "yes" votes than "nos" in order to pass.
